


Process Analysis Essay Outline Template

First Choose a Point of View

1. **First Person Point of View** - Like a narrative you will discuss how **You** perform the process/ task. Use personal pronouns i.e **I, ME, MY, MINE**
2. **Second Person Point of View** - In your essay instructs the reader on how to perform the process/task. Use pronouns **YOU, YOUR**

Introduction

- Define and explain the actual process
- Make your readers understand why the process is important.
- Write the thesis statement; Include the number of steps, the difficulty of the process, and how long the process takes.

- Share any tips to use while performing the process
- Use proper transition words
- Be descriptive

Conclusion

- Refer back to your opening scenario and purpose
- State what the reader is meant to learn
- Describe the finished product/expected result; smell, feel, look taste
